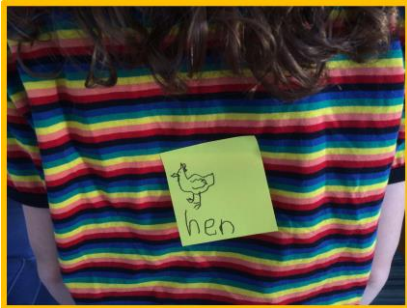

I am learning to ... ask who, what, when, where and how questions.

Can we ...?

Who am I?

- ✚ Play a 'Guess who you are' game.
 - Take it in turns to draw an animal or character on a post-it (or piece of paper) and put on the back or forehead of the other player (without them seeing what it is).
 - Guess who we are by asking each other lots of questions.



Am I an animal?

Where do I live?

What do I like to eat/do/say?

How do I move?

To help me get better at my writing, I could...

- Label my drawing.
- Write a clue to help the guessing player (e.g. 'I like...' or 'I can...').

Top tips to help me learn ...

- ⇒ Use a range of questions (e.g. 'What ...?', 'Where ...?', 'How ...?', 'Why...?').
- ⇒ Help me to ask a range of questions too.
- ⇒ Help me to hear the sounds in each word that I want to write. I could write the first sound of the word next to my picture, or I might be able to try to write the whole word.
- ⇒ Celebrate my learning, what you think I did well and why.
