

Recount of Events on the Road to Emmaus

Imagine you are one of the two men who were walking along the road to the village of Emmaus from Jerusalem. You are discussing the terrible and strange happenings of the last few days, and trying to understand what it is all about.

Write a recount of the day, as if you are one of the two friends walking to Emmaus.

Planning guidance

- Where: On the road between Jerusalem and Emmaus.
- Who: Two followers of Jesus. One was called Cleopas.
- What: Jesus joined the pair on their journey. The two friends were talking about the recent events involving Jesus; him being arrested, crucified and then his body has disappeared from the tomb.



Additional Information:

The two men did not recognise Jesus when he joined them, and it was only when he broke the bread that they knew who he was.

Remember:

- Write in the first person, as if you are one of the men talking on the journey;
- Use a range of vocabulary to describe the different emotions the characters would have felt at different points throughout the story.
