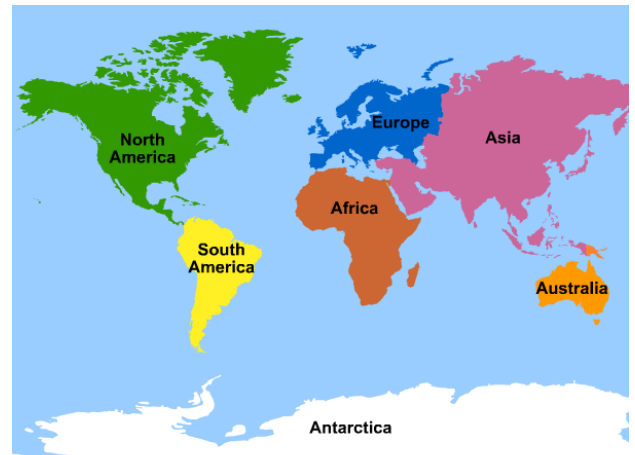


Week 2 - Non-Fiction
