

# Bullying vs Cyberbullying

Use the table to compare cyberbullying with bullying in person. There may be some areas which are the same, but some are different. You can use the bottom boxes to add any ideas of your own.



Bullying in Person	Cyberbullying
The bullying happens verbally, socially or physically, usually at one particular place.	
The person can avoid the bully when they are away from that place.	
The person usually knows who the bully is.	
Other people at that place or in that group might know about the bullying.	
The bully can see if the person gets upset or angry.	
Can have a long-lasting effect on the person being bullied.	
There are ways to deal with the bullies, such as talking to an adult.
